Providing partial tuition scholarships to students who exhibit financial need, technical and artistic potential, and a strong desire to dance is an integral part of Roanoke Ballet Theatre's non-profit mission. We want to make training and performances of the highest artistic caliber available to young people of all ages, backgrounds, and means.

Scholarship applications are reviewed by Roanoke Ballet Theatre's Board of Directors and Executive Director. Completed application forms are accepted on an ongoing basis. No full scholarships will be awarded; only partial tuition scholarships are available to students. Scholarships cannot be used towards registration fees, performance fees, CYB fees, or any other fees outside of general/monthly tuition and will need to be paid-in-full. All applications and financial information are kept confidential.

Scholarship candidates will be evaluated for their technical and artistic proficiency, improvement, dedication, conduct, and progress. Currently enrolled students' previous performance/actions will be taken into consideration in scholarship application and/or renewal. Behavioral issues can cause a student to lose their scholarship privileges and can be removed at any time due to students' actions throughout the year. This is at the sole discretion of the Executive Director.

CLASSES AND PERFORMANCES:

- -In order to qualify and maintain scholarship status, students in Ballet 4 and up must be enrolled in the recommended number of classes for their specific level.
- -Students of Ballet 4 and up are also required to perform in the majority of Roanoke Ballet Theatre's performances during the year. If your intention is not to perform and only to take classes, you will not be eligible for scholarship and/or your scholarship privileges will be revoked.

PART IV: VOLUNTEER RESPONSIBILITIES

Every family of a scholarship student is required to provide volunteer hours to be completed over the course of the school year. Scholarship families need to complete a minimum of 3 hours a month (30 hrs. per registered year; September-June). These hours are in addition to the 2 recommended performance volunteer jobs that are for your students' participation in the shows. These hours are the responsibility of the dancer and family. A volunteer schedule with work needing to be completed remains at the front desk and needs to be initialed after completion of your job. If more volunteer hours need to be met, a charge to your card on file will be placed for the remaining hours at \$10/hr.

Some jobs for scholarship students or their families may include:

- Setting up/tearing down black box seats
- Sewing
- Building set materials
- Finding, making, painting props/sets
- Cleaning the outside of the studio (sweeping pavement, washing windows)
- Cleaning the studio (dusting, bathrooms, vacuuming, washing mirrors, disinfecting barres, collecting trash)
- Developing and distributing marketing or publicity materials
- Transporting sets before and after performances
- Transporting students to festivals or community performances
- Work of fundraising efforts (stuffing envelopes, approaching businesses)
- Volunteering/Chaperoning for shows outside of the 2 recommended jobs for your students' participation.
